

# FATHER'S DAY AND END OF TERM GIVE DAD/TEACHER/CLASSROOM ASSISTANT/COACH/HELPER A UNIQUE GIFT – FEED A CHILD



A year ago, the first turf was dug. Now the Foundation's Resource Centre is home from home to the children of the Ibuluma villages and beyond – it's their place. Some walk 17 km to reach it. They play; they learn skills; they are fed twice a week and are thriving, physically, mentally and socially.

We have crops and vegetables growing; the first goat and hen houses have been built and stock bought in. But we need funds. For the last few weekends, each Saturday and Sunday has seen around 500 kids.

The ancillary costs – maize milling, oil, salt, and foodstuffs to cook and supplement the nsima – the staple dish – are £10 per child per year. Kind folk have sponsored the feeding until the end of June.

Last year's appeal was to make bricks and was tremendous. Latrine blocks, the Whittard kitchen, Sophie's Skills Shed and goat kraal and hen house were able to be erected.

£5 will feed a child for 6 months and a tenner will provide enough sustenance for one year. Sarah has a new Go Fund Me page and as with last year we will provide certificates with donor and recipient names.
